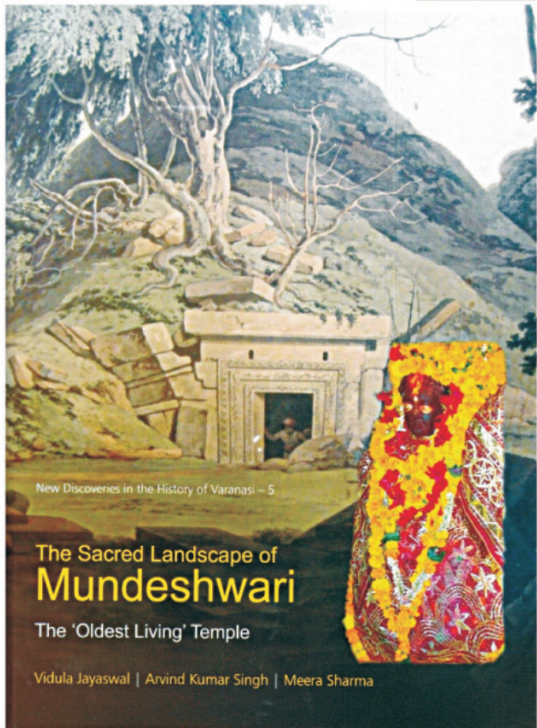

The report of the Mundeshwari project entitled - *Religious Landscape of Mundeshwari : The 'Oldest Living Temple'*, which was finalized earlier was printed and released on August 1, 2017, at the occasion of the Prof. R.C. Sharma Memorial Lecture.

The proceedings of the National Seminar *Significance of Ganga in Indian Culture* (held on November 11th & 12th, 2017), was compiled and edited by Prof. Vidula Jayaswal, Fellow, Prof. R.C. Sharma Chair for Art & Archaeology, Jñāna-Pravāha, who had also coordinated this seminar. The manuscript has been finalized and sent to press.

The report writing of Shooltankeshwar and Saraswati Udyyan continued in this year also. All the illustrations and description of findings have been finalized, and the draft is in the final stage of preparation.

An international workshop entitled - *Project Varanasi : Water Urbanism* of the teams from IIT, Kharagpur; IIT, BHU, Varanasi and Columbia University was organized at Jñāna-Pravāha (March 6, 2018), in which among two, one main deliberation was of Prof. Vidula Jayaswal.

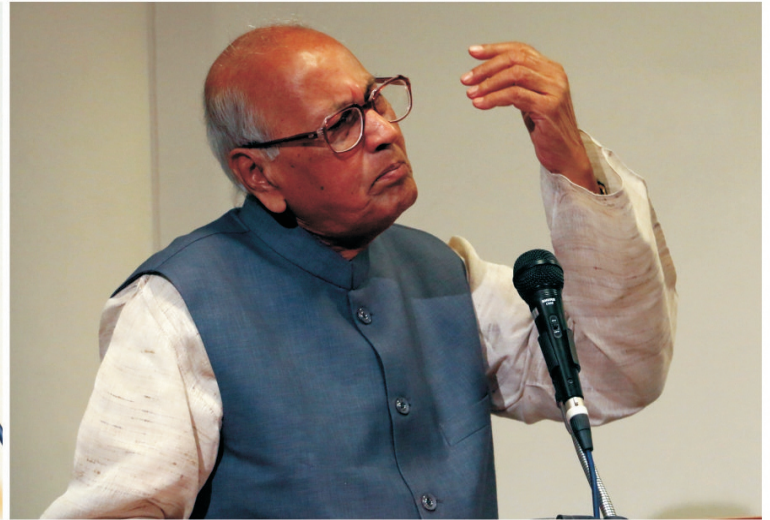
